a unique Labeler Identification Code (LIC) according to ISO/IEC 15459 Unique Identification for the company below. A registered LIC enables unique identification of all logistical levels in a supply chain ranging from product identification to shipment identification and unique marking of all kind of items including related documents (Shipping papers/packing lists, etc.).

The registration of a LIC includes full membership with the European Health Industry Business Communication Council (EHIBCC) and access to documents and support for local, national and worldwide AutoID applications.

3. Local health care providers, i.e. hospitals and pharmacies, may purchase LIC's at the rate applicable to applicants having turnovers of up to 5 million EUR.
4. Renewal fees are payable on each anniversary of the LIC assignment date.
5. EHIBCC warrants that, consistent with the HIBC standard, it will not assign any single LIC to more than one licensee. However, EHIBCC does not undertake any obligation as to result, and EHIBCC shall not be liable for any damages resulting from the use of, or inability to use, any LIC or the HIBC standard. Information given may be recorded in a database for use by EHIBCC.
